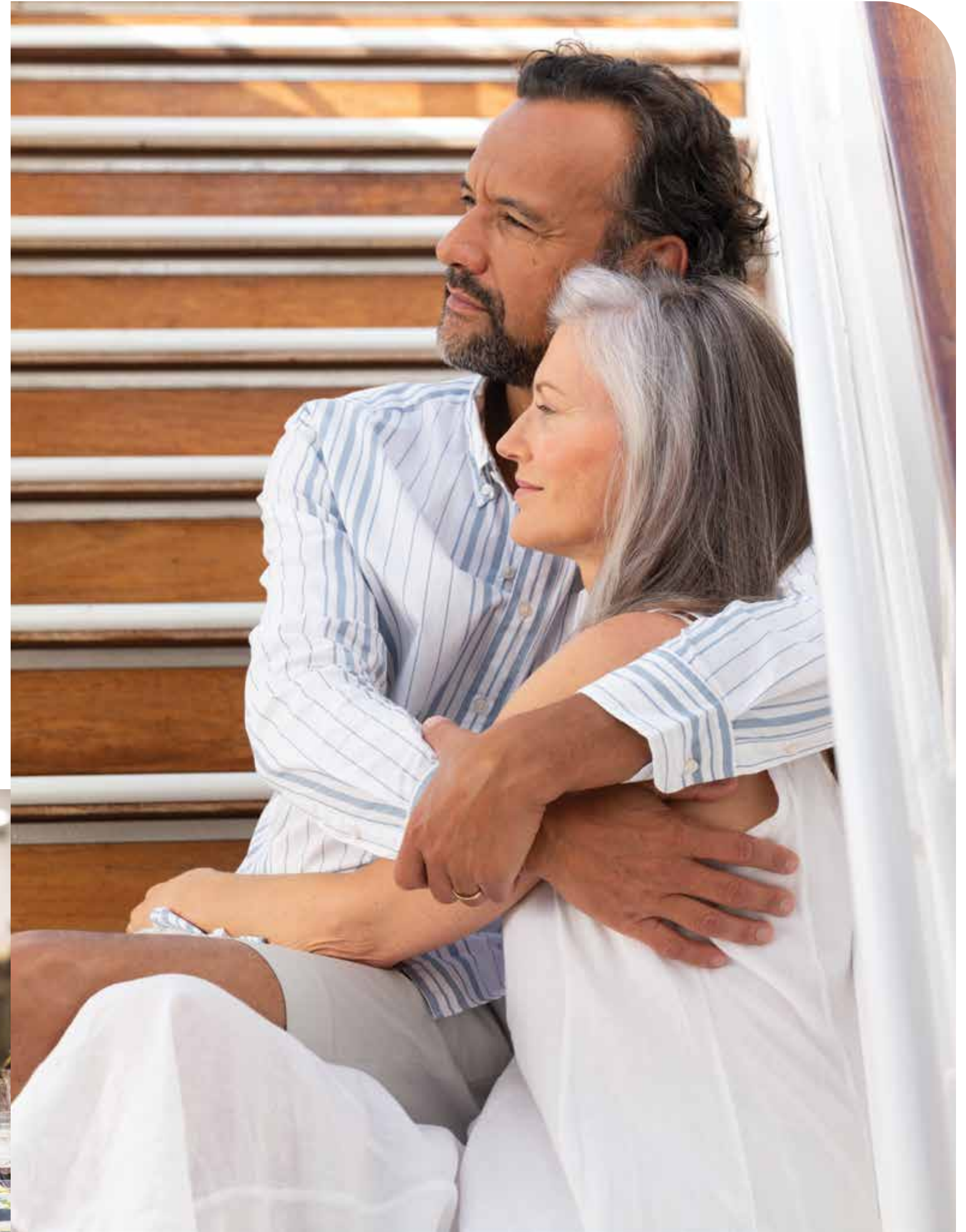

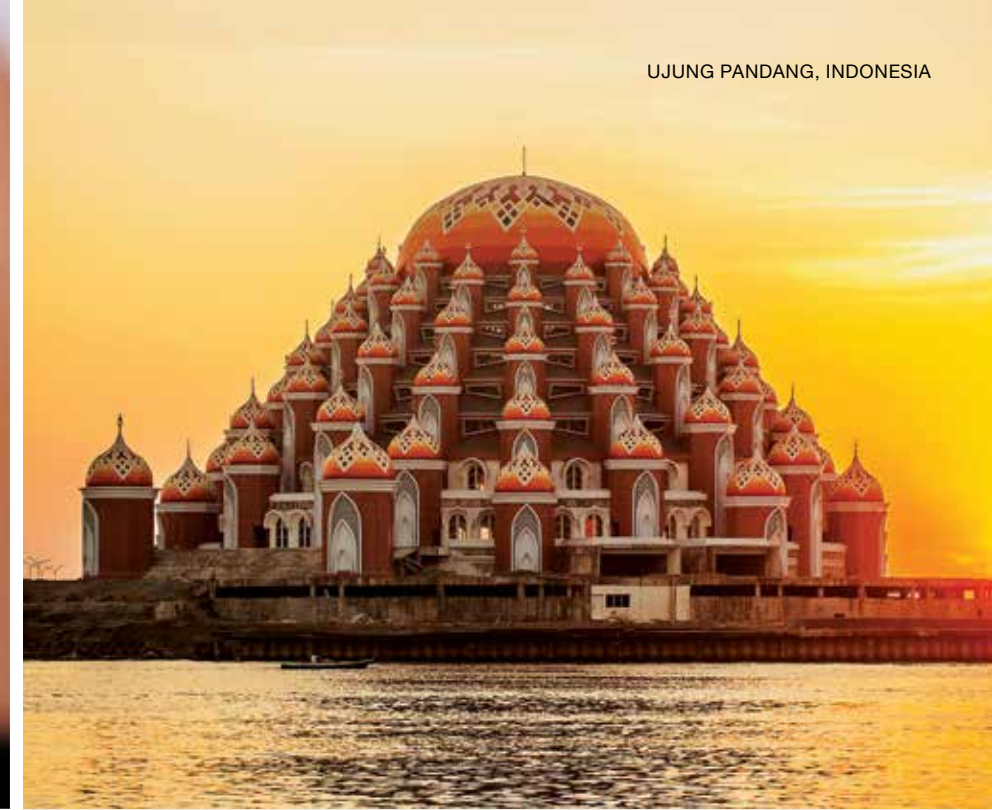

FEATURED EXCURSION: Catamaran Lagoon Cruise with Shark Ray Feeding & Beach BBQ

from Bora-Bora,
French Polynesia

Snorkel and swim among tropical fish, turtles, and schools of stingrays while enjoying Bora-Bora's famous scenery above the surface. Watch from the boat or water as your guide hand-feeds blacktip reef sharks, then visit a private island for a barbecue buffet, drinks, and local entertainment.



DAY 17: HUAHINE, FRENCH POLYNESIA

This hidden gem is the authentic Polynesia you've been longing for. Lush jungle conceals ancient marae temples and a village where you can feed sacred blue-eyed eels for luck. Centuries-old stone fish traps and pearl farms line the lagoon, while the sweet smell of vanilla hints at the orchids nearby. Pure paradise.

DAY 29: EASO, LIFOU, NEW CALEDONIA

This ancient coral atoll eroded over time, leaving steep cliffs behind. Today, the 120-foot-high Cliffs of Jokin offer panoramic views of the mesmerizing

multicolored Lifou lagoon. Or learn more about the indigenous Kanak people with a cultural encounter in one of their traditional conical huts, ingeniously designed to withstand rot and cyclones.



DAYS 34-35: AUCKLAND, NEW ZEALAND

DAY 38: KAIKOURA, NEW ZEALAND

This hidden gem has been referred to as a maritime Serengeti, a fitting sobriquet for the former whaling town. Go whale watching by helicopter in search of resident sperm whales and other migratory species, or kayak or swim the scenic waters for a chance of encountering New Zealand fur seals, dolphins, penguins, and albatross.

DAY 41: OBAN, STEWART ISLAND, NEW ZEALAND

Hikers and bird-watchers will have a literal field day in this tiny settlement. More than three-quarters of the island is within Rakiura National Park, and you might spot bellbirds, tui, fantails, kaka, and other birds inland. Or cruise Paterson Inlet with its glass-clear waters and virgin rainforest, keeping an eye out for yellow-eyed penguins, Fiordland crested penguins, and other species.

DAYS 48-49: SYDNEY, AUSTRALIA

An overnight stay gives you time to visit the famed Opera House; travel back in time to Sydney's oldest urban village, the Rocks; and watch the surfers off Bondi Beach. Or spend the night in the Wolgan Valley, a wild part of the Blue Mountains where you can watch for kangaroos, wallabies, and wombats.



FEATURED EXCURSION: Cape Willoughby & False Cape Winery Long Lunch

from Penneshaw, Kangaroo Island, Australia

The isolation of this part of Kangaroo Island is striking, and you'll have an excellent view from Cape Willoughby Lighthouse, South Australia's oldest, built in 1852. After a look at the granite canyon known as Devil's Kitchen, visit False Cape Winery for a tasting, hearty lunch, and homemade pie.

DAY 57: ROBE, SOUTH AUSTRALIA

Maiden Port

Located on the shores of Guichen Bay, this quaint seaside town lures visitors with beautiful beaches, unspoiled Limestone Coast scenery, old-world charm, and delicious seafood. Take a walk through town past more than 80 historic buildings and sites dating back to the Victoria Gold Rush, or feast on local rock lobster, once the town's main claim to fame.

DAY 63: BUSSELTON, AUSTRALIA

Maiden Port

No visit to Busselton is complete without experiencing what many consider to be its crown jewel — the iconic Busselton Jetty. Walk along the jetty, which stretches over a mile into the bay, for breathtaking views and soothing ocean air. Continue your exploration at the Tuart Forest National Park, which is home to the ancient, majestic, and revered tuart trees.



DAY 69: BROOME, AUSTRALIA

At one point, 80 percent of the world's pearls came from Broome, a testament to the purity of the water here. Our late departure gives you time to pursue the many attractions found at the edge of the Kimberley wilderness — everything from dinosaur footprints and global flavors to a sunset camel ride on 14-mile-long Cable Beach.

FEATURED EXCURSION: Royal Temple, Monkey Forest & Tanah Lot Pagoda

from Benoa, Bali

Bali's legendary beauty is everywhere you look on this excursion. Notice how the ancient Tanah Lot Temple appears to be one with the trees and stone on its tiny island. Admire the garden, water features, and pagodas that make up 17th-century Taman Ayun Temple. And observe the antics of cheeky gray long-tailed macaques as they swing through the mahogany and nutmeg trees of Alas Kedaton forest.



DAY 79: KOMODO ISLAND, INDONESIA

The unspoiled paradise of Komodo National Park is home to endangered Komodo dragons, the world's largest lizard. Seeing one of these living dinosaurs in the wild is an unforgettable experience, and park rangers will do their best to make that a reality as they walk you through the monsoon forest where these mythic creatures live.

FEATURED EXCURSION:
Best of Taroko Gorge National Park & Hualien
from Hualien, Taiwan

Gentle walks and photo stops introduce you to the stunning scenery of Taroko Gorge. Some of Taiwan's highest peaks loom above, while trails lead to dreamy waterfalls, gorges, and colorful temples. Watch for Formosan macaques (rock monkeys) and sambar deer in the forest, then switch gears after lunch as you view the fantastical beasts adorning Taoist Kang-Ten Temple.

DAYS 87-88: HONG KONG, CHINA

This is a city that bustles with business by day and burns the midnight oil by night. Shopping runs the gamut from sleek electronics and fashion stores to traditional bird and flower markets, and there's so much to do. Find a growing number of charming pocket parks between high-rises. Take a sampan to the floating city of Aberdeen. And watch the city lights come on from the top of Victoria Peak or from one of the Star ferries that ply the harbor.

DAY 94: AMAMI, JAPAN

In the heart of the Satsunan island chain, you'll find the serene escape of Amami Ōshima. Wander along its sprawling beaches, where coral



reefs fringe the turquoise waters. Head inward to discover Japan's second-largest mangrove forest. Keep your eyes peeled for the elusive Amami black rabbit, sample the iconic Keihan chicken rice, and admire the delicate local Oshima Tsumugi silk.

DAY 95: TAKAMATSU, JAPAN

Step back to the days of the samurai at Takamatsu Castle; try a bowl of the town's signature Sanuki udon; or head to the town's main attraction, Ritsurin Garden, an Edo-period work of art that took 100 years to complete. With its lakes, small hills, villas, and teahouses, it's one of the most beautiful traditional gardens in Japan, and a must-see when the cherry blossoms are in full bloom.



DAYS 97-98: BUSAN (PUSAN), SOUTH KOREA

An overnight in Busan opens up a world of possibilities. Learn to cook authentic Korean cuisine then dine on your creations. Find inner harmony at 1,300-year-old Jangansa Temple with its smiling Buddha and tranquil bamboo forest. You could also spend your overnight in Seoul with its palaces, markets, and DMZ.

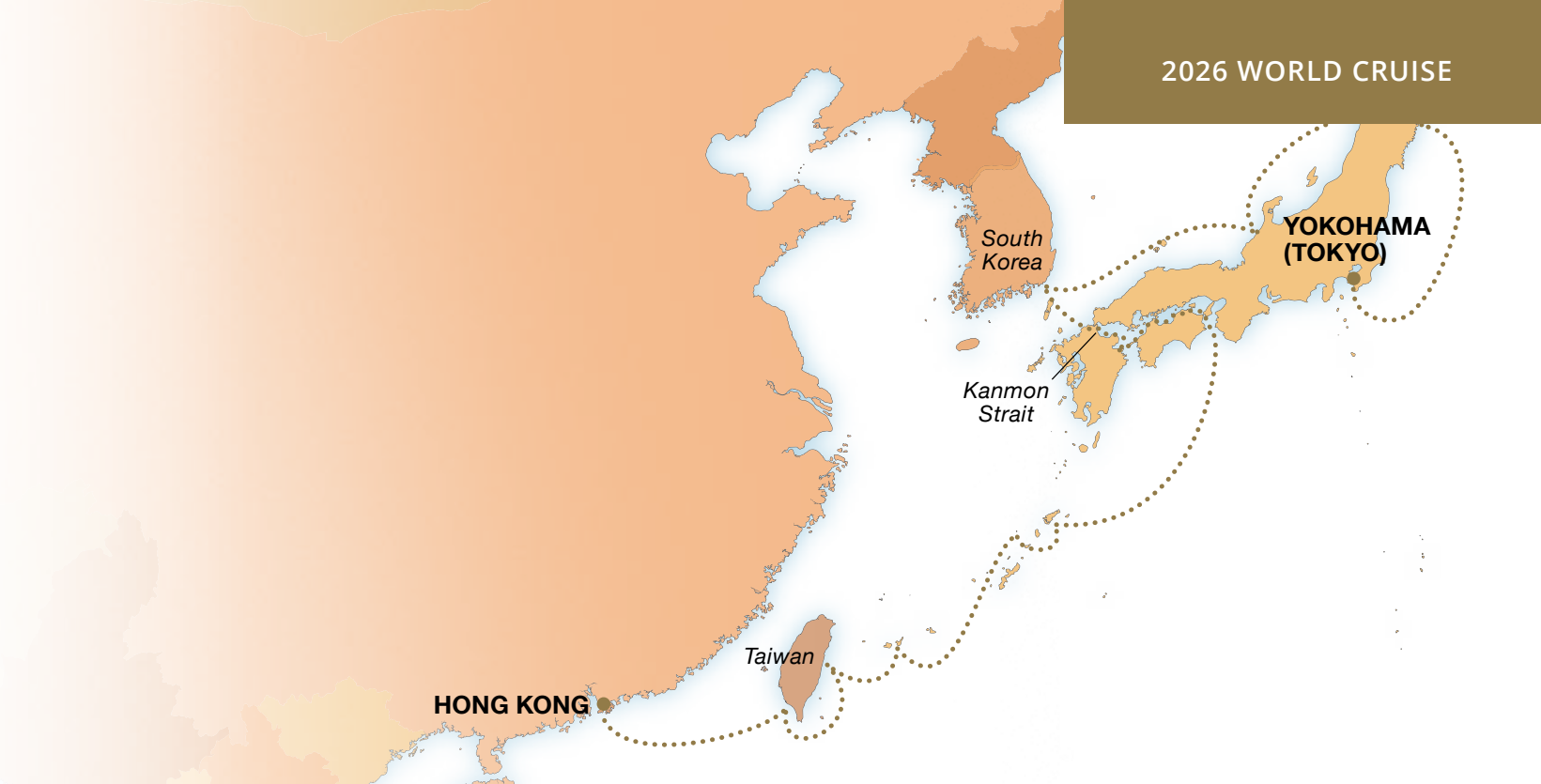
DAYS 100-101: KANAZAWA, JAPAN

Kanazawa was one of the few large Japanese cities to survive World War II largely intact, which makes it a great place to rediscover feudal Japan. There are three historic geisha districts as well as a samurai neighborhood filled with well-preserved buildings, and you can try your hand at traditional crafts like making a sake cup. **In the evening, full-cruise guests can join us for an exclusive, elegant dinner ashore with traditional and modern dishes and time-honored performances.**



FEATURED EXCURSION:
Ryusendo Cave & Kita Yamazaki Geology
from Miyako, Japan

The Sanriku Coast offers a spectacular terrain of high cliffs, white-sand beaches, and jagged peninsulas. Ryusendo Cave is one of Japan's largest limestone caves, with unique stalagmites and stalactites leading the way to vivid blue and green underground lakes. More incredible geology can be found at the Kita Yamazaki Cliffs, towering cliffs and sculpted pillars nicknamed the "Alps of the Sea."

DAYS 107-108: YOKOHAMA (TOKYO), JAPAN

Spend the night in Yokohama, gateway to the world's largest city: Tokyo. Here past and present coexist: historic temples, shrines, and gardens lie tucked away between skyscrapers, modern malls, and neon alleyways. Shop glamorous Ginza and enjoy citywide views from the top of the Tokyo Tower. Or enjoy an iconic Japanese experience as you view Mount Fuji from Hakone National Park.

(baby blue eyes) are in bloom. The mix of blues from the flowers and ocean at Hitachi Seaside Park is worth a visit on its own, but there's also the gorgeous four-tier Fukuroda Falls; a historic sake and beer brewery; and Kairakuen Garden, known for its thousands of plum trees.



DAY 109: HITACHINAKA, JAPAN

Hitachinaka has many attractions, and you'll be there during one of its finest when the Nemophila flowers



FEATURED EXCURSION: Lake Mashū & Geothermal Hokkaido

from Kushiro, Japan

Often shrouded in mist, Lake Mashū is known as the world's clearest lake, considered sacred by the Ainu people since ancient times. Enjoy stunning panoramas from an observatory before making your way to the Mashū Hot Springs area for lunch and perhaps a foot soak in a natural hot spring.

DAY 112: HAKODATE, JAPAN

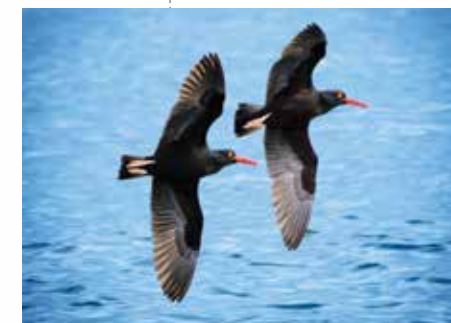
Sights like a Russian Orthodox church and a European-style star fort may seem out of place until you learn this was the first Japanese port to be opened to foreign trade.



Enjoy the magnificent view from Mount Hakodate, or stroll the Morning Market to ponder products like squid ink ice cream and cantaloupe wine.

DAYS 114 - 121: PACIFIC CROSSING

Unwind during leisurely days at sea as you make your way across the Pacific, and join us for fascinating *Seabourn Conversations*®, where luminaries from the arts, sciences, politics, and more present on topics from their field and lead lively discussions. Or visit the Spa for a relaxing massage or facial.



FEATURED EXCURSION: Exclusive St. Lázaria Wildlife Cruise & Lunch at Fin Island Lodge from Sitka, Alaska

Enjoy world-class bird-watching on a cruise to the St. Lázaria National Wildlife Refuge. From May to September thousands of birds show up, and your naturalist guide will help you spot colorful tufted puffins, murrelets, rhinoceros auklets, cormorants, black oystercatchers, and more as you circle the island. A multicourse lunch at Fin Island Lodge caps off the experience.

DAY 122: KODIAK, KODIAK ISLAND, ALASKA

Kodiak languished in relative obscurity until World War II, when it housed thousands of troops, and you can learn about the island's military past at Fort Abercrombie

State Historical Park. Or set off on a guided adventure to photograph the island's namesake Kodiak bears. These massive mammals are a unique subspecies of brown bears that can weigh up to a whopping 1,500 pounds.
