



#### PANAMA CANAL

Experience the Panama Canal's engineering marvel firsthand. Watch as your vessel rises through massive locks, guided by electric "mules" and skilled workers. Cross the Continental Divide through Gaillard Cut carved by steam shovels — and cross Gatún Lake amid jungle islands that were once hilltops. #### **ECUADOR & PERU**

## **MARQUESAS ISLANDS**

Feel worlds away in the Marquesas Islands, where ancient volcanic peaks rise dramatically above turquoise waters. See the lush valleys and archaeological wonders of Taiohae, Nuku Hiva's picturesque main village. On Hiva Oa, explore black-sand beaches, sacred tiki statues, and the Paul Gauguin Museum honoring the artist's legacy. In this remote paradise, nature and culture blend beautifully.



### FRENCH POLYNESIA

Immerse yourself in French Polynesia's dazzling palette of blues and greens, from iconic destinations to hidden gems. ## PAPUA NEW GUINEA, OUEENSLAND & NORFOLK ISLAND

## South Pacific, Hawaii & the Americas

#### SOUTH PACIFIC

Island-hop through the Ring of Fire, delving into both Melanesian and Polynesian traditions. Snorkel Mystery Island's protected waters, untouched by modern development. In Apia, Samoa's sole city, traditional Fa'a Samoa life continues with thatched houses, outrigger canoes, and distinctive tattoos.

#### HAWAII

Hawaii's volcanic archipelago dazzles with natural splendor. From Honolulu, witness North Shore surfers riding massive waves or visit "Mighty Mo," the battleship Missouri in Pearl Harbor. Kona provides access to Hawai'i Volcanoes National Park with its lava tubes and caldera viewpoints. Before departing, enjoy Punalu'u Black Sand Beach where sea turtles rest.

### THE AMERICAS

Along the coastlines of the Americas, you'll find a unique cultural and ecological blend. From Puntarenas get a taste of the Costa Rican countryside at a coffee plantation or wander cloud forests where 14 hummingbird species flutter in specialized gardens. Notice the enduring Spanish influence, from Cartagena's impressive fortresses to Puerto Quetzal's gateway to colonial Antigua, Guatemala's former capital.








## THE GALÁPAGOS

From Guayaquil, visit the Galápagos to explore the unique wildlife that helped Charles Darwin develop his theory of evolution. Your naturalist guide will lead you on boat excursions, nature walks, snorkeling opportunities, and a visit to a giant tortoise sanctuary. Keep your eyes peeled for frigate birds, boobies, Bahama ducks, and the endemic San Cristóbal mockingbird, as well as sea lions, sea turtles, marine iguanas, rays, and more.



#### MACHU PICCHU

Lima, the City of Kings, is your gateway to Cusco and Machu Picchu. See Cusco's Spanish colonial and Incan landmarks from the Temple of the Sun to the Plaza de Armas during an overnight in the city. Then, wind through the Sacred Valley by train to Machu Picchu. Perched on a misty mountaintop in the Andes, the ancient site is a testament to the ingenuity and skill of the Incas.



## ULURU-KATA TJUTA NATIONAL PARK

Your adventure begins with a flight to Uluru, the gateway to Uluru-Kata Tjuta National Park. This ancient desert landscape known as the "Red Centre" is home to one of the world's largest monoliths, Uluru (Ayers Rock), and the sacred red domes of Kata Tjuta (The Olgas). Highlights of your experience include watching the sun rise over Uluru and a magical sunset dinner under the stars at Kata Tjuta.
